Virtual Groups Sermon Guide

Psalm 37

- Pray together for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to behold wonderful things (Psalm 119:18) as your Group meets with the Lord.
- Read Psalm 37 out loud together. Ask two readers to alternate reading the even and odd verses as they voice the psalm.
- This long psalm is a wisdom psalm of David, a collection of proverbs and commands. It is written in a time of lament—the righteous are being afflicted by the wicked. How would such truths comfort a troubled or hurting people?
- Which of these truths comfort you in your situation? Are there any that speak directly to your own heart, soul, mind, and strength?
