[Act it](#) / Family members act out the story while someone reads it. Spice it up by including props, costumes, etc.

Thursday

[Build it](#) / Read the story again. Create an object from the story using legos, playdoh, or other manipulatives.

Friday

[Tell it](#) / Read the story one more time; then call or FaceTime a friend or family member and share the story in your own words. Show them something you created this week.
