Milestones

remembering the work of God

Establishing a token or keepsake is a key component of marking a milestone. In the Scriptures, milestones were often marked with a stone of remembrance—an ebezer. The ebezer served as a visual reminder to the people of God of His faithfulness and provision. Consider ways your family can remember. Perhaps a scrapbook or a photo album. Or a family journal where you can record significant memories, prayers, and lessons from the Lord. Years from now, this ebezer will be a powerful reminder of the faithfulness and provision of God during this unprecedented time.
