Groups Sermon Guide

Revelation 15-16

- → Remember that groups are a place to practice what is preached in community with God and one another.
- → Pray together for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to behold wonderful things (Ps. 119:18) as your group meets with the Lord.
- → Invite some group members to read

 Revelation 15–16 out loud; assign
 paragraphs or sections to different
 members of the group to help with
 reading and hearing the Scriptures.
 This is in keeping with Revelation 1:3—
 Blessed is the one who reads aloud the
 words of this prophecy, and blessed are
 those who hear, and who keep what
 is written in it, for the time is near.
- → Consider the song in chapter 15 as a model for your opening prayer time together.
- → How is the book of Revelation surprising you?

- → Worshiping God is the "true north" to understanding life in light of the Revelation. Share with the group what great and mighty things God has accomplished in your life for which you can praise Him.
- → What do you notice about God's judgment in chapter 16? Share with the group what God has done in your life to help you repent. Where do you need help repenting (turning completely from sin) and how can your group pray for you in that?
