Virtual Groups Sermon Guide

Romans 8:32

- Pray together for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to behold wonderful things (Ps. 119:18) as your group meets with the Lord.
- Ask for a group member to read **Romans 8:31–32** out loud.
- In what areas have you believed that God has been holding out on you? Anything specific during this season?
- How have you neglected being “with” Jesus during these times that has either confused or hurt your understanding of your identity and purpose for Him?
- How might you turn and embrace dwelling with Jesus in this specific season? As a framework, which of the following words best describes where you seem to connect most with Him and His promise of life to the fullest: silence, solitude, or stillness? Share which one stood out to you and examples of being with Jesus in such times and spaces.
- How might you practice one of those times and spaces this week to be “with” Jesus and enjoy His gifts?
