Virtual Groups Sermon Guide

Romans 8:33

- → Pray together for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to behold wonderful things (Ps. 119:18) as your group meets with the Lord.
- → Ask for a group member to read Romans 8:31–33 out loud.
- → Is the posture of your heart most consistently defensive, anxious, or at rest? Share a few examples. What happened out of those times?
- → What is the lie you hear most? That you aren't understood? Too damaged? Too dumb? What's the lie you believe specifically? Do you believe that this lie has more power than Jesus' delight and love for you?
- → Spend time as a group praying against these lies.
- → Ask the Lord to use you this week to encourage those in the group; send texts, make a call, write an email with words of Scripture, encouragement, and truth that negate the lies. Encourage one another and build each other up over the next week in this way.

- □ What is God telling you to do? How can we as a Group be part of giving you courage to obey?
- ☐ How can we pray for you? For your neighbors?
