Virtual Groups Sermon Guide

Colossians 1:9–14

- Remember that groups are a place to practice what is preached.
- Pray together for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to behold wonderful things (Ps. 119:18) as your group meets with the Lord.
- Ask a group member to read **Colossians 1:9–14** out loud.
- Discuss the following questions:
 1. How have you been faced with the reality that you're not as mature as you thought you were?
 2. Where can you reclaim and consecrate time to grow in walking with God as Father and friend?
 3. What is the picture you have in your mind of "Christian maturity"? How in sync is that picture with such descriptions in Scripture?

Weekly Questions for One Another

- What is God saying to you in this Word, in the sermon, and in your walk with Him this week?
- What is God telling you to do? How can we as a Group be part of giving you courage to obey?
- How can we pray for you? For your neighbors?
