Groups Sermon Guide

John 7:37–38

- Remember that groups are a place to practice what is preached.
- Pray together for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to behold wonderful things (Ps. 119:18) as your group meets with the Lord.
- Ask a group member to read **John 7:37–38** out loud.
- How has your picture of what it means to be forgiven and loved by Jesus differed from what we see in Jesus' interaction with the woman caught in adultery?
- How have you sought to “make your home” in Him? Are there rhythms you can add to your life that might help you? Name one, then use the “Weekly Questions for One Another” to discuss and pray over how God is directing you to walk with Him out this Word.

Weekly Questions for One Another

- What is God saying to you in this Word, in the sermon, and in your walk with Him this week?
- What is God telling you to do? How can we as a Group be part of giving you courage to obey?
- How can we pray for you? For your neighbors?
