LOCAL

How to Pray

- Pray that God would identify one person to pray for and talk with in your neighborhood.
- Take a walk around your neighborhood and pray for the houses you walk by. If you see someone else outside, engage them in a conversation and maybe ask to pray for them (while keeping 6 ft apart of course!)

GLOBAL

How to Pray

- Pray for Beirut: Beirut experienced a deadly explosion this week which destroyed their port, their main source of food and income. This has left thousands in need in the midst of an already tense economic and political atmosphere.
 - Pray for open doors for the Gospel and for opportunities for believers to share.
 - Pray for homes to be restored quickly and for continued safety. Most people with homes destroyed will have to move.
 - Pray for the laborers who are present in country right now. Specifically for safety and healthy processing.
 - Pray for peace for the Lebanese people. Lebanon has been through so much already and now this has taken peoples home and rattled their hearts.
