# Groups Sermon Guide

**John 14:25–31**

- Remember that groups are a place to practice what is preached.
- Pray together for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to behold wonderful things (Ps. 119:18) as your group meets with the Lord.
- Ask a group member to read **John 14:25–31** out loud.
- Where is it difficult for you to rehearse trust in Christ in the middle of trial?
- What compensates for peace in your life instead of Christ?
- Use the “Weekly Questions for One Another” for a further discussion and extended prayer time together over the specifics shared in the group.

## Weekly Questions for One Another

- What is God saying to you in this Word, in the sermon, and in your walk with Him this week?
- What is God telling you to do? How can we as a Group be part of giving you courage to obey?
- How can we pray for you? For your neighbors?
