LOCAL

How to Pray

How to Pray

- Pray that our missionaries overseas would stay healthy and be used as lights to share the hope of the gospel with those around them.
- Pray for the Carley family as they continue to take steps to move their family to the Middle East:

- For financial provision
- For intimate time together as a family and with friends as they say goodbye
- For safety in travel and transition

- Continue to pray for Beirut as they recover from two deadly explosions last month that left many homeless.
