# Groups Sermon Guide

**Matthew 28:18–20; Ephesians 1:22–23**

- Remember that groups are a place to practice what is preached.
- Pray together for the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to behold wonderful things (Ps. 119:18) as your group meets with the Lord.
- Ask a group member to read **Matthew 28:18–20** and **Ephesians 1:22–23** out loud.
- Have you ever had a spiritual conversation with a friend or coworker? How did it affect your relationship and intimacy with Jesus?
- Who has God placed in your orbit that you can begin to pray for and seek to have a spiritual conversation with?
- Spend some time as a group lifting up the names of people with whom you've had or hope to have spiritual conversations. Pray for our church to grow because people are coming to a saving knowledge of the Lord Jesus.

## Weekly Questions for One Another

- What is God saying to you in this Word, in the sermon, and in your walk with Him this week?
- What is God telling you to do? How can we as a Group be part of giving you courage to obey?
- How can we pray for you? For your neighbors?
