



OUT IN THE HARVEST *

LOCATION: NORTH AFRICA DATES: MAY 24-JUNE 1

Have you ever wanted to wander the beautiful streets of urban North Africa praying and asking God to lead you to spiritually open people? That's exactly what you'll do on this trip. After an orientation with the long-term team and learning some gospelsharing tools, you'll go out into the city in groups, prayer walk, and engage locals in conversations. You'll eat local food, take local forms of transportation, and befriend people from this predominantly Muslim country, all with the hopes of getting to introduce them to Jesus the Messiah.

TRIP REQUIREMENTS

Must be able to attend pre-trip trainings. Must have a passport with six months validity from date of return.

PRAYER WALK IN THE HARVEST

LOCATION: MIDDLE EAST

DATES: TBD

We are partnering with an organization whose vision is to see prayer teams cover 172 prominent cities in a particular part of the Middle East with on-the-ground prayer. These are cities that have little if any gospel witness. Come pray, asking God for people of peace, and "plowing the spiritual field", with the desire to ultimately see a church planted in that city.

You'll do an orientation with a long-term team in a nearby major city and then take local transportation to a more remote part of the country. Once settling in you'll spend three to four days strategically prayer walking the city and creating a prayer 'map' of where you've walked. There will be very few Western amenities and few English speakers which will create the perfect environment to depend on the Lord's leading throughout your time.

After those few days, you'll return to the major city and debrief with the long-term team, passing along your prayer map and any contacts you made in the prayer city. You'll return home with the knowledge that you may have been the first people to pray to Jesus in that particular city and that any church that forms there in the future will be traced back to these first prayers.

Along the way you'll get to experience local culture and see some of the most well-known historical sites in the world.

BUSINESS CATALYZATION: PHASE 1



LOCATION: NAIROBI, KENYA TRIP 1: JANUARY 6-14, 2023

On this Phase 1 trip, business professionals will be introducing basic business principles to the participants. The team will be facilitating a class of local entrepreneurs through the following components of the business training curriculum:

- Foundational Principles of a Biblical Business
- Godly Motivation: Factors of Success and Failure
- Mock Business Plan Competition: Developing a Kingdom Business Concept
- Becoming a Servant 1: Market-Driven Business
- Stewardship 1: Intro to Finance and Budgeting
- Homework: Independent Market Research

The business training curriculum provides everything the coaches will need to facilitate the training but with plenty of freedom for them to add their own personality and Style.

BUSINESS CATALYZATION: PHASE 2



LOCATION: NAIROBI, KENYA TRIP 1: FEBRUARY 10-18, 2023

Phase 2 of the business training curriculum is a unique oneon-one mentoring phase. When Phase 2 coaches arrive on site, the local entrepreneurs will have already learned basic business principles in Phase 1 and answered a comprehensive list of market research questions regarding their potential business. The responses to these questions form the basis for each business plan.

Phase 2 coaches work with three or four local entrepreneurs and, with the help of a translator, assist each entrepreneur in the creation of a business plan. The most critical part of this phase is to work out the business finances to make sure the business is viable. In addition, the entrepreneurs are expected to develop a Kingdom Impact Strategy, which details how they will use the business to share the Gospel. The finished business plan will be assessed by the program committee to determine whether it is worth considering for financial assistance and advancement to Phase 3.

BUSINESS CATALYZATION: PHASE 3

LOCATION: NAIROBI, KENYA

TRIP 1: APRIL 12-20

Phase 3 of the business training curriculum is the final phase of teaching in the business training curriculum program. Coaches will be facilitating a class of local entrepreneurs through more detailed concepts than Phase 1 and will have the benefit of completed business plans from Phase 2. The primary components of the Phase 3 curriculum are outlined below:

Showing Christ through Relationships in Business Becoming a Servant II: Marketing Your Business Growing in Humility: Sales and Service (Sales Pitch Competition) Stewardship II: Managing Your Money, Savings, and Loans/ Long-term Planning Funding Terms Graduation











South Asia

LOCATION: SOUTH ASIA TRIP 1: APRIL 12-20 TRIP 2: APRIL 19-27


