
Missional Restoration




The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is the self-existent, perfectly holy, infinitely glorious triune God—the Creator of all that is. Men and women were created in His image to enjoy relationship with Him and one another. He saw all that He made and said it was 'good.'



But, sin entered God's good world. Adam and Eve belittled and blasphemed God by attempting to be God. On our own, we don't desire God. We desire to be God. Without the intervention of the triune God, we are shackled to our sinful desires and unable to live without sin. Our sin separates us from the God who is holy and just. This is the worst news.



Here is the best news: God has not abandoned us! The Son came into His creation to be the Crucified King. Born as the man, Jesus, He lived the life that we could not live and died the death that we should have died.
