It was easy to imagine more TVC campuses sprouting up across the Metroplex. The Lord was certainly using our one church in multiple locations to spread the gospel and change lives, and it seemed perfectly logical that He would have us expand even further.

As it turned out, He did—just not in the way anyone was expecting. After much prayer and consideration, our elders felt compelled by the Holy Spirit to increase our reach by decreasing our locations through the effort of church planting.

They presented a plan called "Multiply" to the church body, which would begin transitioning our five campuses into autonomous churches that would be better equipped to minister in their local contexts, just as we had done with our Denton campus in 2015.

We committed to rolling off all of our campuses by 2022, and by the grace of God, that has finally come to pass. On July 4, 2021, our Southlake campus celebrated its first service as Restoration Church, joining The Village Church Denton, Citizens Church, Northway Church, Redemption Story Church—and The Village Church—in autonomy. Your generosity has helped establish these healthy churches, and we can't wait to see what the Lord does in Denton, Plano, Dallas, Fort Worth, Southlake, and Flower Mound in the years to come.
