This semester we are learning about the attributes of God. **An attribute is a word that tells us what someone or something is like.** Knowing God's attributes teaches us about His nature and His character.

January Memory Verse

"He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power." Hebrews 1:3

- **January 3 : Incomprehensible**
God is incomprehensible. He is bigger than we are able to understand.
Jesus Is Baptized (Matthew 3:1–17)
- **January 10: Holy**
God is holy. He is completely perfect and separate from sin.
Jesus Is Tempted (Matthew 4:1–11)
- **January 17: Creator**
God is creator. He made everything.
Jesus Calms the Storm (Mark 4:35–41)
- **January 24: Sovereign**
God is sovereign. He has the right, wisdom, and power to do everything He pleases.
Jesus' Authority over Demons (Luke 4:31–37)
- **January 31: Generous**
God is generous. He gives what is best.
Jesus Heals a Man Who Can Not Walk (Luke 5:17–26)

February Memory Verse

"The Lord is good to all, and his mercy is over all that he has made." Psalm 145:9

- **February 7: Good**
God is good. He is what is best.
Parable of the Hidden Treasure (Matthew 13:44)
- **February 14: Provider**
God is provider. He meets the needs of His people.
Jesus Feeds the 5,000 (Matthew 14:13–21)
- **February 21: Glorious**
God is glorious. He shows His greatness and worth.
Jesus' Transfiguration (Matthew 17:1–13)
- **February 28: Merciful**
God is merciful. He does not give His children the punishment they deserve.
Parable of the Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11–32)

March Memory Verse

“Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.” Philippians 2:9–11

- **March 7: Compassionate**
God is compassionate. He sees, cares, and acts when His children are in need.
Jesus Raises Lazarus from the Dead (John 11:1–44)
- **March 14: Worthy**
God is worthy. Only God deserves all glory.
Jesus’ Triumphal Entry (Matthew 21:1–11)
- **March 21: Just**
God is just. He is right to punish sin.
Jesus Clears the Temple (Matthew 21:12–17)
- **March 28: Loving**
God is loving. He does what is best.
Jesus Dies on the Cross (Matthew 27:1–66)

April Memory Verse

“It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to sing praises to your name, O Most High; to declare your steadfast love in the morning, and your faithfulness by night,” Psalm 92:1–2

- **April 4: Almighty**
God is almighty. Nothing is too hard for Him.
Jesus’ Resurrection (Matthew 28:1–10)
- **April 11: Patient**
God is patient. He is slow to anger.
Jesus Appears to the Disciples (John 20:19–29)
- **April 18: Faithful**
God is faithful. He always does what He says He will do.
Jesus Promises the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:1–10; 2:1–8)
- **April 25: Wise**
God is wise. He knows what is best.
Saul’s Salvation (Acts 9)

May Memory Verse

“Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever.” Hebrews 13:8

- **May 2: Attentive**
God is attentive. He hears and responds to the prayers of His children.
Peter Is Rescued. (Acts 12:1–19)
- **May 9: Deliverer**
God is Deliverer. He rescues His children.
Paul and Silas Are Delivered From Jail (Acts 16:16–40)
- **May 16: Refuge**
God is refuge. He is a place of safety and protection for His children.
Paul Is Shipwrecked (Acts 27)
- **May 23: Unchanging**
God is unchanging. He never changes.
