June Memory Verse

“And he said to him, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.” Matthew 22:37-39

- **June 6 : Know**

Big Truth: Knowing God means believing the Bible is true.

Text: Isaiah 43:10 & 1 John 4:14-16

- **June 13: Love**

Big Truth: Loving God means seeing Him as most valuable.

Text: Deuteronomy 6:5, John 3:16, & John 14:15

- **June 20: Trust**

Big Truth: Trusting God means confidently relying on Him above anyone or anything else.

Text: Psalm 9:10, Psalm 28:7, Psalm 56:3-4, Jeremiah 17:5-8, Hebrews 11, Proverbs 3:5

- **June 27: Obey**

Big Truth: Obeying God means knowing, loving, and trusting Him enough to do what He says.

Text: John 14:15 & 1 John 5:3
